Re.: SAMPLE FDI Moot Competition Team Sponsorship Pledge

The undersigned hereby pledges to sponsor a team in the FDI Moot on the following basis:

1. The team is from [university, city, state, country].¹
2. The sponsorship shall be in the amount of [US\$ or € XXX.00].²
3. This pledge shall remain in effect with respect to competitions held before 31 December 20[10].³
4. The sponsor will pay the sponsorship funds directly to the qualifying team when the FDI Moot's Administrative Office confirms the team's registration.⁴
5. If the sponsored team withdraws, it shall reimburse all sponsorship funds to the sponsor.⁵
6. [Optional] If a sponsorship is taken up in any year, it shall renew automatically on the same basis for subsequent years.⁶
7. All pledges will be listed on the competition website; the logos of those pledging an amount equal to or greater than the competition registration fee will be displayed as website banners;⁷ sponsors whose pledge is taken up by a team will be listed in the printed program for each competition.

¹ We encourage sponsors not to be restrictive. They may list an order of priority if they wish. If more than one qualifying team seeks sponsorship, the first to register will be entitled to the entire sponsorship pledged, unless indicated otherwise by the sponsor.

² This does not become payable unless and until a qualifying team takes it up.

³ We recommend a three-year period, but at least until the end of 2009.

⁴ The team and Administrative Office will take all reasonable steps to facilitate tax-advantageous treatment.

⁵ The Administrative Office will only refund the registration fee - less bank charges - to teams that withdraw before memorials become due. Reimbursement of the sponsor is solely the team's responsibility.

⁶ In other words, the sponsor pledges to top up the pledge from year to year.

⁷ From the time the pledge is made until it is no longer in effect according to point 3. above, or it has been consumed and the sponsor has not elected to top it up according to point 6. above.
