In each group, the top 4 teams advance. Within each group, teams are ranked according to wins, then [Neustadt/ Sonneborn-Berger](#) (SB) score, then preliminary round oral points.

Due to the extraordinary situation of the Kenyan Presidential election being annulled on Friday many arbitrators who had been scheduled to sit in preliminary hearings stayed home.

This necessitated the use 2 arbitrators per hearing as an emergency solution and averaging the scores of the two actual arbitrators for the score of the third fictitious arbitrator. This was done for all preliminary matches.

¹ Claimant/Respondent Skeleton Brief Scores were weighted (Cmem or Rmem * 0.25) into each match to determine the points.
